

DECLARING A MINOR IN AFRICAN AMERICAN STUDIES

Here are four easy steps to guide you in pursuing a minor in African American Studies.

STEP 1

Download the minor declaration worksheet from the African American Studies website or come to our offices in 287 & 289 Bowen Hall to complete the form.

STEP 2

Take your completed minor declaration worksheet to your academic advisor in your department where you will take a major. Don't miss this step; it is important that your major advisor knows about your declaration of a minor, so that you can be properly advised when choosing courses. Have your advisor sign the form, and make a copy for the files, if desired.

STEP 3

Return the minor declaration form to African American Studies for filing. You'll meet with the director of the program and be assigned a minor faculty advisor at that time.

STEP 4

During the pre-registration period in the fall and spring make an appointment with your minor faculty advisor. Your minor advisor is a supplement to your major advisor, and will help guide you in choosing courses for the minor in African American Studies.
